

## **INSTRUCTIONS FOR SUBMISSION OF PAPERS TO AGECON SEARCH**

Congratulations on the acceptance of your Contributed Paper!

The American Agricultural Economics Association has asked us to contact you with instructions for posting a full-text copy of your Selected Paper on *AgEcon*. In accordance with a decision of the AAEA, all accepted Contributed Papers must be submitted to *AgEcon Search* by 8 a.m. June 1, 2006, or they will be dropped from the AAEA program.

If you are not already familiar with our site, *AgEcon Search* is an electronic library dedicated to collecting, indexing, preserving, and distributing full-text copies of scholarly research in the discipline of agricultural and applied economics. ### **PLEASE FOLLOW THESE INSTRUCTIONS**

- 1) PASSWORD:** The Web Submission Form for *AgEcon Search* is available by choosing the link "Submit Papers" on the *AgEcon Search* homepage (<http://agecon.lib.umn.edu>). Select the AAEA 2006 listing and use the password: **agecon**
  
- 2) COVER:** Each paper must have a cover page which includes the following information: title of the paper, author(s) name, affiliation of the author(s), and the name of the conference. A sample cover page is attached. We suggest that you include a copyright statement at the bottom of the cover page. You, as author of the paper, retain the copyright of the paper. The following is a sample copyright statement that you may use or adapt for your paper.

- 3) FORMAT:** The papers on *AgEcon Search* are posted in PDF format. Name your file with the six digit tracking ID of paper (i.e. #143143.pdf). Be sure to review the PDF file you have created before sending it to verify that text and formulas have transferred correctly. **DO NOT SUBMIT A WORD DOCUMENT TO AGECON SEARCH.** If you are not able to prepare a PDF file or to use the online submission form, please send your file as an e-mail attachment to Louise Letnes at: [lletnes@umn.edu](mailto:lletnes@umn.edu).
  
- 4) VIEWING YOUR PAPER:** Once a paper is received at *AgEcon Search* it goes through a verification procedure before it actually appears on the web. Check back in a day or two to verify that your paper is on *AgEcon Search*.
