

INSTRUCTIONS FOR SUBMISSION OF PAPERS TO *AGECON SEARCH*

All accepted Selected Papers must be submitted to *AgEcon Search* by May 31, 2007, or they will be dropped from the AAEA program.

PLEASE FOLLOW THESE STEPS FOR SUBMITTING YOUR PAPER

1) COVER: Each paper must have a cover page which includes the following information: title of the paper, author(s) name, affiliation of the author(s), and the name of the conference. A sample cover page is attached. We suggest that you include a copyright statement at the bottom of the cover page. You, as author of the paper, retain the copyright of the paper. The following is a sample copyright statement that you may use or adapt for your paper.

Copyright 2007 by [authors(s)]. All rights reserved. Readers may make verbatim copies of this document for non-commercial purposes by any means, provided that this copyright notice appears on all such copies.

2) FORMAT: The papers on *AgEcon Search* are posted in PDF format. Name your file with the last name of the first author (i.e. smith.pdf). Be sure to review the PDF file you have created before sending it to verify that text and formulas have transferred correctly. DO NOT SUBMIT A WORD DOCUMENT TO *AGECON SEARCH*. If you are not able to prepare a PDF file or to use the online submission form, please send your file as an e-mail attachment to Louise Letnes at: lletnes@umn.edu.

3) SUBMISSION: Go to *AgEcon Search* (<http://agecon.lib.umn.edu>) and choose Submit Papers from the left navigation bar.

- Choose American Agricultural Economics Association - 2007 from the drop-down box
- **Use the password: agecon**
- In the e-mail box, enter the e-mail for the person submitting the paper
- In the author box, enter each author along with e-mail addresses if available
- In the series box, enter: Selected Paper (no.) – i.e., Selected Paper 117877
- Fill in all other fields, using 2007 in the date field.
- The submission form will then prompt you to upload the PDF file from your computer

4) VIEWING YOUR PAPER: Once a paper is received at *AgEcon Search* it goes through a verification procedure before it actually appears on the web. Check back in a few days to verify that your paper is on *AgEcon Search*. All papers submitted to *AgEcon Search* will be moved to the new *AgEcon Search* website (<http://ageconsearch.umn.edu>) during the month of June.
