Prior to joining UNICA, Dr. Jank founded and led the presidency of the Brazilian Institute for International Trade Negotiations (ICONE). Previously, he worked at the Division of Integration, Trade and Hemispheric Affairs of the Inter-American Development Bank (IDB) in Washington, DC, and was a Visiting Professor at the Universities of Georgetown, Missouri-Columbia and others. He also conducted consultancy projects for the World Bank, OCDE, FAO, PNUD, Hewlett Foundation, Swiss Development and Cooperation Agency (SDC), United Kingdom International Cooperation Department (DFID), and German Marshall Fund of the United States (GMF). He is also a Director of the Agribusiness Department of the São Paulo Industry Federation and an Associate Professor at the School of Economics and Business of the University of São Paulo.
