Graduate Student Teaching Award

The TLC is sponsoring this award to recognize and encourage graduate students who excel in teaching agricultural or applied economics courses.

Nominations may be submitted by any member(s) of the AAEA and selection is made on the basis of nominating materials. Re-nominations are encouraged, providing materials are updated and resubmitted. Graduate Student Teaching Award is a criterion-based award and is reviewed by a committee of TLC members.

Selection Criteria

The following three major areas are considered in evaluating nominations:

1. Quality of teaching.
2. Personal commitment to teaching and self-development as a teacher.
3. Involvement in undergraduate extracurricular activities.

Eligibility

The nominee must have been involved in course instruction (including laboratory, discussion sections, help section, and online courses) for a minimum of one year (2 semesters or 3 quarters) or the equivalent). Nominee must have been a graduate student in good standing within the year previous to the nomination.

***Applicants must hold a current Graduate Student Membership in AAEA.**

Award and AAEA Presentation

The winner will receive a plaque and cash award of \$500, be recognized at the Teaching, Learning and Communication Section Business Meeting and make a presentation during the Teaching Tips from Top Teachers session at the Annual AAEA Meeting. The winner will be expected to attend the Annual Meetings to receive their award. Consent of nomination implies that the nominee has an intention and, if selected for an award, will make a reasonable attempt to attend the annual conference.
