### **Position Description**

An on-going full time benefit eligible Postdoctoral Research Associate position is available immediately at Cooperative Research Programs at Lincoln University in Missouri. The Postdoctoral Research Associate appointment is for a one year term with continuation based on funding availability and performance.

Start Date: Available immediately.

Qualifications: The successful candidate should have a Ph.D degree in agricultural economics, economics, or a closely related field. The candidate should have a strong training and experience with econometric models, specifically with discrete choice models. Previous experience with using statistical software such as Stata is required. The candidate should also have previous experience with economics of bio-energy and adoption of new technologies.

The duties will include: 1. developing survey instruments and conducting agricultural household surveys on adoption of energy crops, 2. conducting econometric and statistical analysis of the survey data, 3. writing research outputs, including journal articles and abstracts.

Lincoln University is located in Jefferson City, MO, near the geographic center of the state. Jefferson City serves as the state capital, its scenic capitol dome overlooking the Missouri River. Jefferson City and its adjacent Columbia have a combined population of around 150,000. The Columbia-Jefferson City area has quite a diversity of natural scenery, with lakes, flatlands, rivers, caves and rock formations all within a fairly small radius. Additionally, this area is about equally distant from Kansas City to the west and St. Louis to the east, which makes it a convenient connection point for both.
