Vernon Eidman was a member of the faculty at Oklahoma State University, 1964-1975, and the University of Minnesota, 1975 – 2007, where his areas of specializations were production economics, agribusiness management and renewable energy. His responsibilities included undergraduate and graduate teaching, research, and extension programs. He served as Head of the Department of Applied Economics from 1998 to 2004. Service to AAEA includes membership on the Executive Board, 1989 – 1992, and President in 1996. He was elected a fellow in 2003. A native of Illinois, Vernon received his BS and MS degrees from the University of Illinois, and PhD from the University of California, Berkeley.
