



Presentation title: "Agricultural Policy Analysis: The Good, The Bad, and the Ugly"

Barry K. Goodwin is William Neal Reynolds Distinguished Professor in the Departments of Agricultural and Resource Economics and Economics at North Carolina State University. He holds a Ph.D. in economics from North Carolina State University. He has held faculty positions at Kansas State University and The Ohio State University. His teaching, research, and outreach efforts have addressed a wide range of problems in agriculture including policy, trade, risk management, price analysis, and econometrics. He has been on numerous editorial boards and has participated in a wide variety of activities important to the advancement of the agricultural economics profession. His research is widely cited and he has received numerous research awards, including outstanding article awards from the AAEA, the WAEA, and the CAEA. He served on the AAEA Board of Directors from 2009-2011 and is on the Executive Board of the International Agricultural Research Consortium (IATRC). He was inducted as a Fellow of the AAEA in 2006.
