

# USDA Seeks Nominations for NAREEE Advisory Board and Subcommittees

## Deadline April 26, 2019

The U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) seeks nominations of qualified individuals for the National Agricultural Research, Extension, Education, and Economics (NAREEE) Advisory Board. The 15-member NAREEE Advisory Board reviews and makes recommendations on top priorities and policies for food and agricultural research, education, extension, and economics.

Members serve two- to four-year terms depending on the Board or committee and represents different sectors of agricultural research. The current openings include:

### **NAREEE Advisory Board: 1 Open Position**

- One individual representing non-land grant colleges of Agriculture (NLGCA) institutions or Hispanic serving institutions.

### **Specialty Crop Committee: 3 Open Positions**

- Three individuals who represent the specialty crop industry

### **National Genetic Resources Advisory Council: 9 Open Positions**

- Three positions to represent scientific issues (agricultural science, economics, policy, environmental science, natural resource science, health science, and nutritional science)
- Two positions to represent the general public (public policy, community development, trade, international development, law or management)
- Four positions with expertise cultivar development and animal breed development

(**Note:** 4 of the members of the NGRAC must also represent the 1862 Land-grant Universities, the 1890 Land-grant Universities, the Hispanic Serving Institutions, or a 1994 Equity in Education land-grant university)

### **Citrus Disease Subcommittee: 8 Open Positions**

- Three individuals who are citrus producers from Florida
- Four individuals who are citrus producers from California or Arizona
- One individual who is a citrus producer from Texas
