### AAEA Job Fair – What is it?

- The AAEA Job Fair provides a casual, meet-and-greet setting for employers and job seekers in agricultural and applied economics.
- Employers from business, government, non-governmental organization, and academia are welcome.
- Job seekers at all stages (toe-dipping included) with BS, MS, and PhD training in agricultural and applied economics.
- Networking is the primary goal of the Job Fair, so employers need not have a specific position on offer, and job seekers need not be in the market at the current moment. During the 4-hour fair on Sunday, August 5, employers can describe their missions, workplace, and the kinds of jobs they tend to fill. Job seekers can communicate the skills and experience they offer.
